

07/07-08 VILLAGE DESIGN STATEMENT

Cllr M Groves announced that Chale had been awarded £2005 from Awards for All. 08/07-08 DEAD ELMS ON THE GREEN

There are a number of dead elms on the green reaching over 12feet tall. There is some concern over the potential hazard this may cause if they\were to fall. 10/07-08 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING

Gladices Barn development has been approved. Cllr M Groves highlighted the many pre-conditions regarding the development. The Councillors have ensured that they will monitor this development in order to enforce conditions.

It was proposed that Wendy Arnold (IWC) is to monitor the development and report back to Parish Council every quarter.

Wendy Arnold expressed concerns over light pollution in regard to light coming out of the skylights intended at Gladices Barn.

11/07-08 CLERKS REPORT

Admin: Councillors had to sign new mandates for bank accounts in order for new Clerk to receive bank statements.

12/07-08 COUNCILLOR REPORTS

Cllr M Groves has a meeting with Beacon Editor who wants to know if there any comments from Chale Parish Council. Cllr D Overton felt that it was not well publicised and there were not enough copies available.

Cllr D Overton went to a meeting about Chale Day. It will be held on the Green on Sunday 17th June which is Fathers Day and may be the theme. Music and Food have been suggested by Village Partnership.

Cllr D Overton highlighted that Chale Village Partnership was not on the agenda and that it should remain a permanent item.

Wendy Arnold apologised in advance for her absence from the Annual Parish Meeting to be held on 23rd April.

Norcross Ices have been asked to re-submit to planning in consideration for a pitch, they need to provide definite trading points.

In May there will be a forum in Niton with the local Police Officers and PCSO's. Wendy Arnold intends to invite the Officers to Vernons. Clerk is also to follow up PCSO Louise Shorter to see if she is able to attend the Annual Parish Meeting.

Wendy Arnold is also monitoring the Corbe Farm buildings and is trying to get Steve Cornwell to visit.
